
### **ABOUT US**

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

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

### INTERNATIONAL ACCREDITATION





The Teacher Education Professional Diploma (TEPD) at Queen Rania Teacher Academy is granted Accreditation at the initial-licensure level from the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP).

**QRTA becomes the first educational organization in Jordan** to be fully accredited by CAEP for the coming seven years, and the third educational organization in the Middle East to obtain the CAEP accreditation, after the United Arab Emirates University and Zayed University, making Jordan the second country in the region to receive such recognition after the UAE.



# Total CPD beneficiaries in 2021






#### Teaching and Leading in Emergencies/Crises




