
### International Recognition







### New Programs in 2022

Psychological Adaptation Skills during Crises and Emergencies Program This program provides ample learning opportunities for educators, such as teachers, counselors, and school principals, by addressing topics related to mental health and psychosocial issues. It aims to build a community of practice at target schools that fosters a social support system to promote students' psychosocial wellness and develop their psychological adaptation skills, so as to reengage them in the learning environment given the challenges posed by the new norms.

This program is a continuation of the series of psychosocial support programs offered by QRTA that have contributed to the development of learning and working communities in Jordanian schools since 2012.


